DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Soil Applied: MicroEdge® Zn 9% is recommended for use on all types of soils, it should be diluted before use to ensure uniform coverage. Soil applications may be made in band or broadcast fertilizer applications. Apply band, side-dress or broadcast 0.5- 4 quarts per acre. Formulated and compatible for use in all suspension fertilizers

Foliar Applied: Avoid applying this product when plants are suffering from moisture stress. If there are any doubt, apply the spray solution to a small test area of the crop to access any undesirable effects or phytotoxicity may result. Apply 1- 2 pints per acre.

FIRST AID

PREVENTION: Wash thoroughly after handling.

IF IN EYES: Call a POISON CENTER or doctor if you feel unwell. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. Rinse eyes cautiously with lukewarm, gently flowing water for several minutes, while holding the eyelids open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.
